

Battery Replacement

Instructions

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read and follow the important safety instructions before servicing the batteries. Visit CyberPower official website
- www.cyberpower.com or contact your dealer for more information on battery replacement.
- CAUTION! Use only the specified CyberPower replacement
- battery, or battery pack. CAUTION! Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. The batteries
- may explode.
- **CAUTION!** Do not open or mutilate batteries. Released material is harmful to the skin and eyes. It may be toxic.

Take the following precautions before replacing the battery: 1. Remove watches, rings, or other metal objects.

- 2. Use tools with insulated handles
- 3. Wear rubber gloves and boots.
- 4. Do not lay tools or metal parts on top of batteries.
- 5. Determine if battery is inadvertently grounded. If inadvertently grounded, remove source from ground
- CONTACT WITH ANY PART OF A GROUNDED BATTERY CAN RESULT IN ELECTRICAL SHOCK. The likelihood of such shock can be reduced if such grounds are removed during installation and maintenance (applicable to equipment and remote battery supplies not having a grounded supply circuit).

- Place the UPS on its top and remove the retaining screw (figure 1) . Slide the battery compartment cover completely off of the unit (figure 2).
- Remove the battery from the compartment and disconnect the battery wires from the battery. Install the replacement battery by connecting the red wire to the positive (+) terminal and the black wire to the negative (-) terminal of the battery. (figure 3)
- 4. Slide the battery compartment cover over the battery and tighten the retaining screw. Charge the unit for 4-8 hours to ensure the UPS performs expected runtimes.

MODEL: CP850AVRLCD, CP1000AVRLCD



1. Place the UPS on its side and locate the battery compartmen cover on the bottom of the UPS. Remove the four (4) retaining
